WHAT IS NATIONAL BOARD CERTIFICATION?

National Board Certification is a designation that is earned when teachers demonstrate standards-based evidence of positive impact on student learning.

There are four components for which NBC candidates must submit evidence:

- Content Knowledge
- Differentiation in Instruction
- Teaching Practice and Learning Environment
- Effective and Reflective Practitioner

WHY APPLY?

1. Fee Support

Eligible candidates have the cost of their components covered.

2. District Support

Candidates have access to support from Professional Learning Facilitators as they work on their components.

3. Financial Benefits

Salary incentives up to \$17,000 are available to Maryland teachers who achieve, and maintain National Board Certification.

4. Growth as an Educator

National Board Certified educators cite the NBC process as some of the best professional development they've ever experienced!

ELIGIBILITY

Educators in a "Teacher" job title who have taught at least three years are eligible to apply for National Board Certification fee support.
